CONFESSION continued: CONTRITION may be perfect or imperfect depending upon the motive why we hate sin. If we hate sin because it offends God who is good and deserving of our love, we have perfect contrition. If we hate sin because we fear the punishment of hell, we have imperfect contrition. Either kind will suffice for confession.

AMENDMENT: Coupled with contrition must go a firm purpose of amendment. This means that a person is ready to quit sinning; ready to quit those persons, places or things that are an occasion of sin. This does not mean that a person will not sin in the future. He may or he may not. The point is here and now he is determined to do all in his power to avoid sin.
